VINTAGE: The growing season of 2022 started out well with good weather during flowering and fruit set. However, the vines set a lighter than average crop for the third year in a row. The lighter crop ripened quickly and hot weather in August accelerated the harvest to one of the earliest and quickest in recent memory. But this lighter crop delivered fruit with excellent concentration and complexity that gave us a lower volume of outstanding wines.

WINEMAKER NOTES: Light straw color, Raeburn North Coast Sauvignon Blanc has aromatic notes of white flowers and citrus. A bright and round mouthfeel with tropical notes of guava, Meyer lemon and key lime are followed by a crisp finish.
