- Vineyards: 48% Campobello Vineyard, 35% Owsley Vineyard both in the Sebastopol Hills and benefit from Goldridge soils (fine, sandy loam), 13% MacMurray Vineyard, 4% Balletto Vineyard
- Over 80% of the grapes are from Green Valley AVA
- Dijon clones
- Small open top fermentation
- 100% French oak for 11 months, 40% new
- Coopers: Francois Ferrer, Remond, and Boutes. Med and Medium Long toast levels
