2023 | SONOMA COUNTY

VINIFICATION:

Our Pinot Noir grapes were carefully selected from throughout Sonoma County's premier vineyards. Once the grapes arrived at the winery, our winemaker crafted the grapes in the Provençal style: direct to press with minimal skin contact to provide a light salmon hue. We cold rested the juice on the lees prior to fermentation to release the delicate flavor compounds, then quickly followed by fermentation in 100% stainless steel to preserve the essence of the fruit to create a beautifully balanced, crisp and refreshing Rosé.

*** Note: During the final blending stage of the 2023 Rose our winemaker was able to utilize 100% Russian River Valley fruit to create this year's wine. While labelled Sonoma County, the 2023 is indeed 100% Russian River Valley fruit.*

VINTAGE: Despite a late start, the cooler weather continued, providing ideal conditions for the grapes to achieve proper balance and brix plus deep concentration and complexity. While the harvest extended weeks longer than the previous year, it was well worth the wait for the outstanding fruit it produced. The 2023 vintage will be one of the finest in years, producing wines with beautiful flavors, vibrant acidity and remarkable balance.

WINEMAKER NOTES: Light rosé in color, Raeburn Sonoma County Rosé begins with beautiful floral and raspberry aromas complemented by subtle Earl Grey tea notes. The palate is marked with lush flavors of strawberry hard candy, juicy watermelon and guava followed by a luxurious yet light finish.
